It's exhilarating to know that your car can take you anywhere you want to go, in the comfort and style you expect.

Moorlands, streams, tracks, woodlands and deserted beaches suddenly become your own private landscapes when you drive a Discovery. And if you want to be more adventurous, you needn't limit your horizons - the Discovery has already tackled a marathon drive through the Sahara desert and survived the worst that sand dunes, treacherous rocks and blistering temperatures can offer.

Land Rover's decades of experience in building tough, reliable four wheel drive vehicles mean that both the sporty three-door and family five-door Discovery have an unbeatable pedigree when it comes to tackling terrain that other cars can't even contemplate.

Sophisticated, permanent four wheel drive gives exceptional grip, balance and traction, so the Discovery has leech-like road holding. The vertical movement of wheels over a rocky road normally causes bumps and lurches, but the Discovery's coil spring suspension, absorbs the movements to give you an extraordinarily comfortable ride.

A choice of two technologically advanced engines - the highly acclaimed and economical direct injection 200 Tdi diesel and the punchy V8i engine, which runs on unleaded petrol - are linked to a five-speed manual gearbox and transfer box, with high and low ratios, to offer pulling power when you need it and speed when you're back on the road again. And if you're in a really tricky spot, you can lock the Discovery's centre differential, distributing power equally between its front and rear wheels to give you maximum traction.

The Discovery's towing ability opens up more new worlds. Hitch up a caravan or a trailer loaded with a boat, windsurfers, motorbikes, a racing

car - or simply your holiday tent and luggage and you're ready for action. The Discovery will cruise to your destination, smoothly and easily.



It has impressive reserves of strength and

can tow the weight of six Minis or five Metros - any amount up to 4,000 kilos on a fully-braked trailer*- so no family's needs are likely to strain it.

But driving the Discovery isn't simply a matter of enjoying your freedom, although with top speeds of up to 106 mph for the V8i and 91 mph for the Tdi (where allowed), you can make the most of motorways and autobahns and eat up the miles to your destination, cruising comfortably within the speed limit and your car's capabilities.

The box-structure chassis is the basis of the Discovery's stability and resilience, giving a low centre of gravity and maximum protection from impact damage. The driving position is high and commanding, allowing you to look over the roofs of most other cars and see any dangers lurking ahead. And all-round visibility is remarkable, since the Discovery boasts panoramic views through its wide laminated



windscreen, toughened glass side windows, and rear door glass.

All the features which make the Discovery a supreme family and leisure car will help you to rise above the traffic jams and irritations of

town driving too. It's a sophisticated and infinitely practical alternative to an ordinary saloon, which can take the family's shopping, your business equipment and passengers - all at once.

A Discovery can carry up to 801 kilos - that's three fashion models, a photographer and his assistant, plus everything they need for a photographic session, from cameras and lights to clothes, and a portable changing room. So whatever you need for a last-minute presentation or a school run won't cramp its style, or yours. And because of its power steering, and tight turning circle, it's easy to park as well.

Inside, the Discovery is as thoughtful and chic as you'd expect-

stylish, practical and exceptionally spacious - and it's available in either Sonar Blue or Bahama Beige, with everything from the steering wheel and gear lever to the upholstery and carpets carefully co-ordinated.

The tallest driver won't be cramped by its commanding driving seat, while passengers enjoy unusually good headroom, even in the back seats. The raised rear section of the Discovery's roof gives them a sense of airiness and a wonderful view, as well as generous room to spread themselves - and their belongings.

On the three door model, the front seats have a featherweight tilt release, foot-operated by back seat passengers, so access is never a problem.

Storage has received the same meticulous attention to detail as the rest of the Discovery and everything you need is always conveniently close to hand. Map pockets are above the sun visors and there are large

stowage compartments inside the front and rear end doors, plus pockets on the back of the front seats. There are even nets on the ceiling to hold extra maps and papers.



In the rear load area there are more stowage hold-alls as well as room for as much luggage as you need. The five-door Discovery comes



with two extra folding rear seats in this section and three-door drivers can order them as an option, so you can carry seven passengers comfortably.

Of course, all the back seats

fold down if you want to transport fewer people and more equipment. You can even choose to lower just one section of the split rear seats to increase the luggage space - no combination of passengers and luggage is too complicated for the Discovery.

Unusual ease of operation is another of the Discovery's strong points, one that's earned it praise from a host of motoring experts. The instruments are clearly laid out on the dashboard in front of the driver, flanked by the switches which operate rear windscreen washers and wipers, rear fog lamps and the heated rear window. Other controls are on column levers. And the Discovery is the only British car to offer remote radio controls on the dashboard so that the driver can change frequency, programme and volume thereby enhancing driver convenience and safety.

On five-door models, the Discovery also features new alloy wheels, central locking on all doors, electric windows, headlamp powerwashers,

electric door mirror adjustments, heated door mirrors and a coin holder, plus a retractable cover for the rear luggage space and removable centre console bag.

Most are available as factory-fitted options on three door models as well along with extras such as twin sun roofs, air conditioning and towing equipment. There's also a catalytic converter for the V8i engine, which already runs on unleaded petrol, so we can all try to keep our planet cleaner and safer.


You can choose from a wide range of 15 colours for your Discovery, with four different paint finishes. There are even side stripes added to give pizzaz to three-door models.

And if the Discovery still hasn't answered all your needs, ask your dealer about the range of accessories which were developed alongside the vehicle itself - everything from a CD player autochanger to gas-assisted retractable rear step and fixed side steps to dog guards, baby seats, a roof rack with ladder nudge bars and lamp guards.

Chassis The Discovery's box-structure chassis is the basis of its strength, durability and exceptional on and off-road performance. Combined with aluminium body panels it gives the car a low centre of gravity, which makes it unusually stable, and provides maximum protection from impact damage.

The chassis has been designed to minimise mud traps - a big plus point on an all-terrain car and is treated with Land Rover's special electrophoretic anti-corrosion process which ensures an even and hard-wearing coating of the chassis by using electricity to create a chemical bond between the metal and paint which covers it.


<u>**Transmission**</u> The five-speed manual gearbox is linked to a transfer gearbox so that you can select a high gear ratio for roadwork and longdistance driving or a low gear ratio for cross country driving or towing a heavy load. This

means that you can choose from ten forward and two reverse gears to suit any motoring need.

As with all Land Rover products permanent 4 wheel drive is a standard feature. But when conditions are really bad - in snow or mud,

for example - the Discovery's centre differential can be locked to minimise the possibility of wheel spin and give you even better traction.

Suspension The Discovery's suspension enhances safety and performance by incorporating beam axles for strength, resistance to



damage and high ground clearance. Most cars travelling across rough ground will jolt their passengers, but the Discovery's long-travel coil springs absorb jars and bumps and give a superbly comfortable ride.

The dual rate rear springs are also tuned to adapt to the laden

condition of the vehicle and to allow for driving over both even and uneven surfaces, ensuring uniformly safe and smooth ride and handling.

Brakes Large diameter, servo-assisted disc brakes front and rear give the Discovery all the stopping power you'll ever need. For extra peace of mind and security especially in off-road conditions the parking brake locks the transmission.

The V8i engine The new V8i engine, which runs on unleaded petrol, gives consistently better performance, reliability and economy than a conventionally aspirated, non-injection engine. It delivers a top speed of 106 mph where permitted, with improved power (+13%), torque (+10%) and economy (+14% urban cycle).

A special in-tank pump and pressure regulator are controlled by a small computer linked to sensors on and around the engine to meter the exact amount of fuel needed for the job your Discovery is doing - so economy and performance are constantly adjusted to your needs.

All this technology contributes to service intervals a full 12000 miles apart and although the V8i performs well within prevailing EC emissions legislation, a closed loop catalytic converter is also available as an option for those customers who require it.

The 200 Tdi engine This specially-developed diesel engine has already won praise for its combination of economy, reliability and longevity and for its superior acceleration and reduced noise levels. With a top speed of 91 mph where permitted, it returns 42.3 mpg, at a constant 56 mph, 28.9 mpg at 75 mph and 30.5 mpg in town.

A direct injection system squirts fuel straight into the cylinder, instead of injecting it via another chamber, so no fuel is wasted and the engine stays cleaner for longer.

The fuel pump monitors your performance demands and ensures that the engine receives precisely the amount of fuel it needs. An intercooler keeps the fuel mixture at the best temperature for maximum

fuel economy and performance and a turbocharger utilises exhaust gases to give maximum performance and economy.

All this means that the oil needs changing only every 6,000 miles, and full services are 12,000 miles apart. And the 200 Tdi engine is designed to be



environmentally sensitive - a special three-point engine mounting minimises noise and vibration, while traces of oxides of nitrogen, hydrocarbons and carbon monoxide are well below EC limits.




